A Proclamation Recognizing Tigertail Beach in the City of Marco Island

WHEREAS, South Florida is one of the most spectacular and popular bird

watching destinations in the world, with coastlines that act as migration superhighways for shorebirds, songbirds and birds of

prey, and

WHEREAS, the 2,000-mile Great Florida Birding Trail, a conservation tool fueled

by the rapidly expanding hobby of bird watching, is now complete, with the unveiling of the fourth and final leg of the trail, the South

Section, and

WHEREAS, this new section spans 12 counties, showcases 116 prime bird

watching sites for both novice and expert birdwatchers, and

provides remarkable glimpses of Florida's wildlife, and

WHEREAS, Tigertail Beach in the City of Marco Island was selected for the

South Section from over a thousand applicants, and is one of the best all-around birding sites in southwest Florida—a true "hot-spot" during migrations; its sandy beaches, dunes and mudflats provide valuable nesting, resting and feeding grounds for over 60 species of

migratory and resident coastal birds, and

WHEREAS, the volunteers of the Friends of Tigertail Beach, in partnership with

state, county, and city organizations, have provided stewardship and education to foster community appreciation and understanding of this unique habitat to protect this valuable resource and to ensure future generations of Marco Island citizens will be able to view its

amazing diversity of shorebirds, waterfowl, and wading birds.

NOW THEREFORE, be it proclaimed by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida, that Tigertail Beach is hereby recognized for its remarkable ecosystem which makes it such a magnificent bird habitat deserving of special recognition by its selection for the Great Florida Birding Trail. Further, that all citizens are urged to celebrate the stewardship efforts of all the valuable partners, especially by the Friends of Tigertail Beach volunteers.
